RULES....REGULATIONS AND CAMPING POLICIES

CAMP RANGER: (Where available)

Leaders/Contact Person MUST check in on arrival and out on departure. Camp Ranger's services should be utilized during working hours, Please co-ordinate your requirements at time of booking camp. Unless for emergency reasons.

Camp Ranger will tour you through the site you have booked on arrival and will explain the operation of the camp and any issues or concerns he/she may have,

The Camp Ranger will also be available at checkout time, to go over the site before you leave camp.

DRUGS..ALCOHOL & TOBACCO:

- Use of any narcotic drug will not be permitted
- **First-Aider is supplied by the Group**
- **Any Injury or Incident that occurs on Camp Property, must be reported to the Ranger or Camp Committee as soon as possible**
- Alcohol is NOT permitted on site at any time
- Smoking only in DESIGNATED areas. The balance of camp is non-smoking. All buildings are non-smoking

PETS:

Pets are not allowed anywhere at camp

MEMORABILA:

No unauthorized items are to Hung, Placed, or Attached on Walls, Ceilings or Rafters in any buildings without permission. No Nails, Tacks, Staples, are to be used on buildings (inside or out) or on any trees at camp

CARS..RV'S..CAMPERS..TRAILORS:

No Campers, RV's, or Trailers on site without permission. Parking for cars and small trucks in designated parking areas only. Roadways must be kept clear for emergency vehicles at all times. Speed limit at all camps 10 kilometers per hour. No Off Road Motorcycles, Quads, All Terrain Vehicles at camp.

SWIMMING REGULATION: see B.P & P

Qualified Lifeguard in Attendance for all water events (PROVIDED BY THE GROUP)

Personal flotation devices must be worn at all times when boating

OBSTACLE & CHALLENGE COURSES:

Are Restricted to Scouting members only

GENERAL CAMP GUIDELINES:

*Leaders are responsible for the health, safety and conduct of their camps

*Groups are responsible for your own First Aid Person

*Trees must not be cut on or off the property. Except as designated by the Camp Ranger

* Fires only at designated Campfire sites. No fires on the foreshore. Charcoal fires must be laid in the Campfire area only or in BBQ. Ensure that there is one bucket full of water and one of sand available when using sites

- Camp Lanterns, stoves and heaters are not to be used in any cabins or tents
- Firearms, fireworks, sling shots are not allowed in camp
- Flagging tape and all trail game markers must be removed on completion of activity
- Drinking water must be obtained only from designated sources of supply, surface water and streams are UNSAFE
- Personal washing and washing of dishes must be done on the unit campsites or designated area. Not at the water taps .Hot water plus disinfectant must be used for dishes.
- Bull Horns are not to be used anywhere at camp
- Raiding of other Tents...Huts. .Lodges.. Camp Sites is Forbidden
- Be cautious with outdoor cooking fires & lodge fireplaces. .During hot dry weather **Fire restrictions will be applied**, you may be required to use camp stoves only.
- Out-of-Bound Area.. Roadways.. Workshops.. Residences.. Private Property located outside of camp boundary
- Firewood is provided at some camps. .please confirm on booking. If not available you must bring your own. Do not cut down trees for firewood. Chainsaws are not permitted at camp...
- Any Graffiti, Vandalism, Damage to equipment will be charged to the Group.
- CHAPEL is open to everyone and is not restricted or booked to one group.

CLEAN UP

- Groups are responsible for **all** clean up of Lodges, Campsites, Shelters, Washrooms, or other areas used by the Groups while at camp. A cleaning charge may apply if need be.
- **ALL** garbage is to be removed from camp, unless garbage bins are supplied at camp. Leave camp better than you found it.
- Camps do not supply any cleaning supplies, food, dishes... Please check with the camp you are booking for a list of items supplied and the items you need to bring.

Scouting is NOT RESONSIBLE for any loss or damage to group's personal items.
